

This is what you will have to deal with... consequences of breaking school rules

In the following table, we have indicated what is considered as breaking school rules. Underneath each misdemeanour are the possible consequences the child may be confronted with, at the discretion of the teaching member involved. In extreme cases, parents will be informed of the incident immediately.
