

School Agreement

Preamble

The German School Nairobi is a lively and open school which promotes cultural diversity. The ambiance is characterised by mutual respect and tolerance, politeness and cooperativeness.

Parents and teachers alike acknowledge their responsibility in educating the children, as well their duty of being role models for the children. Our students recognise their rights and duties, and behave responsibly.

For optimum cooperation, we follow the basic rules:

Dealing with others:

- We deal with each other in a considerate, friendly, prejudice-free way, and recognise each other as independent, equal personalities.
- We greet each other.
- We think of feelings of others, and do not hurt or humiliate anyone.
- We highly value positive behaviour and good results.
- We use appropriate language.
- We express criticism factually, and own up to our mistakes.
- We resolve conflicts openly and constructively, and do not engage in violence of any kind.

Dealing with property:

- We deal responsibly with all property belonging to the school or to others, and avoid damage of any kind.
- We keep the school compound and our classes clean.
- We look after our environment.

Co-operation:

- We show interest in all aspects of school life, and contribute positively to ensure the school day runs smoothly.
- We work together constructively, meaning we talk about issues openly.
- We inform and support each other mutually.
- We recognise the fact that each student, as well as teacher has the right to a motivating and an undisturbed lesson.
- We take responsibility for the school community.
